Did they enjoy their Christmas Day?

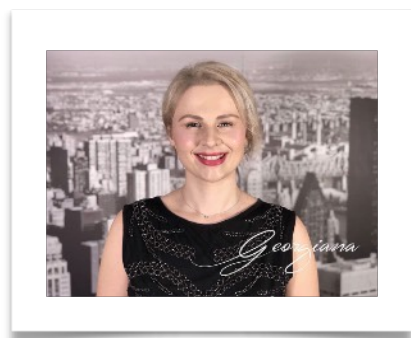
Yes, they had a wonderful time celebrating together.
